



Review of Major Indictments—English Abstract

1. Indictments against elected public servants, or private persons employed in positions of trust who, if the indictment is presented, may be require to leave their employment, shall be reviewed.
2. A review panel shall be established in each geographical district of Israel.
3. Each panel will consist of one chairman elected for two years by members of the district bar association, and seven other members of the bar, chosen by lot monthly. For each indictment, one member of the panel will be selected by the chair to argue against adopting the indictment.
4. A majority of the panel must approve the indictment for it to be presented.
5. The state will bear the cost of the members' wages and service for a month will count against the member's annual reserve duty, if any.
